HarbourWatch

HarbourWatch is where slow coffee meets slower views. Perched at the water's edge within the Maritime Museum, it's part café, part lookout — and a destination for events that want the harbour as their backdrop. The tone is calm but confident. Think soft neutrals, warm timber, brushed metal and endless glass — a palette that reflects the light and lets the view lead.

It's coastal, but not cliché. Understated, but never forgettable.



Ben Lexcen Terrace

Perched above the boardwalk at the Maritime Museum, the Ben Lexcen Terrace is a rooftop gem with sweeping views of the city skyline and harbour. Spacious and versatile, it's ideal for cocktail parties, pre-dinner drinks, product launches and exclusive events that call for a touch of glamour. Often paired with the Lighthouse Gallery, this terrace offers a spectacular open-air setting in the heart of Darling Harbour.

Terrace Room

Brilliant by day and dazzling by night, the Terrace Room is the museum's premier waterfront venue. With floor-to-ceiling windows framing sweeping views of Darling Harbour and the city skyline, it offers a striking blank canvas for your event. Perfect for gala dinners, cocktail parties, trade shows or conferences, it's a versatile space designed to impress.

Wharf 7

An unconventional gallery on the harbour, Wharf 7 blends sailing history with contemporary design. Surrounded by legendary wooden vessels from the Sydney Heritage Fleet, its light-filled spaces, timber details and soaring ceilings create a unique backdrop for intimate dinners, cocktail parties and boutique events that call for both character and atmosphere (evening events only).

The Lighthouse Gallery

Expansive and light-filled, the Lighthouse Gallery offers a striking museum-style interior framed by floor-to-ceiling windows with sweeping harbour and city views. Perfect for product launches, gala dinners, cocktail events and conferences, it combines scale with flexibility – even allowing access for cars, boats or large installations via its loading dock. A dramatic, versatile space that makes a lasting impression.

HarbourWatch South

By day, a vibrant marina; by night, city lights across the harbour. Overlooking the Maritime Museum's heritage fleet, the Waterfront Studio is an intimate harbourside space ideal for team workshops, small meetings or creative breakouts. With bi-fold glass walls that open directly onto the boardwalk, it's also perfect for post-event cocktails and canapés, often paired with Ripples Waterside for larger celebrations.

With state-of-the-art presentation equipment, plush tiered seating and superb acoustics, The Theatre is purpose-built for impactful corporate events. Venue hire includes full AV facilities, with the adjacent Tasman Light Gallery providing the perfect space for registration, catering and pre-event gatherings.

City View Room

Nestled between HMAS Onslow and HMAS Vampire, it's a versatile venue that combines architectural style with a unique maritime backdrop — ideal for cocktail parties, intimate dinners or as a refined wet-weather option by the water.

HMAS Vampire (II)

Once part of the Royal Australian Navy, HMAS Vampire now offers upper decks and a helipad made for sunset drinks, striking photo moments and one-of-a-kind celebrations. With the harbour as your backdrop, it's a venue that promises impact, atmosphere and memories that linger long after the night ends.

Tasman Light Gallery

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Location

We are located at 2 Murray Street, Darling Harbour, within the Australian National Maritime Museum precinct.

Parking

Secure paid parking is available at Harbourside Car Park on Murray Street, ICC Sydney Car Park, and Wilson Parking at Darling Quarter. Limited metered street parking is also available in Pyrmont and Darling Harbour. Taxis and ideshares can drop off directly at the museum entrance.

Pyrmont Bay light rail station is also just a short walk away, with regular ferry services to Pyrmont Bay Wharf and nearby bus stops providing easy access from the city and surrounding suburbs. Town Hall and Wynyard train stations are both within a 10-15 minute walk.

Accessibility

The Maritime Museum precinct is fully accessible, with lifts and ramp access available.
